Teacher Instructions

Sightseer is a sight reading game.

Using sheet music, choose a random note on the page and ask the student to play it. If they play the exact note you pointed to, fill in a bubble in a set. If they play the wrong note, cross out a bubble instead. Each filled in bubble counts as 1 point. A crossed out bubble is not worth any points.

A game of Sightseer includes 2 sets, with a total of 20 possible points. Record the number of points for each set and the total for that game.
